Pursuant to my authority under sections 1-1.5-104(1)(d), 1-1-107, and 1-1-110, Colorado Revised Statutes, and in accordance with the Order issued on November 3, 2008 ("the November 3<sup>rd</sup> Order") and stipulation of the parties as approved by the Court on October 29, 2008 in *Common Cause of Colorado et al., v. Mike Coffman*, Civil Action No. 08-cv-2321-JLK-KMT, United States District Court for the District of Colorado, I now ORDER as follows:

1. A review by this office has determined that the ineligibility of certain individuals on the list of cancelled voters provided pursuant to the November 3<sup>rd</sup> Order was not established by clear and convincing evidence.
2. Pursuant to the November 3<sup>rd</sup> Order, the county clerk and recorder in Arapahoe, Denver, Eagle, Grand, and Larimer counties shall count the ballots of voters whose ineligibility the Secretary of State has determined has not been established by clear and convincing evidence.
3. The list of voters whose ballot shall be counted pursuant to this Order will be transmitted electronically to the counties listed above and shall be confidential pursuant to section 1-8.5-111, Colorado Revised Statutes.
4. The county clerk and recorder in the above-listed counties shall amend the county results submitted to the Secretary of State by Thursday, December 4, 2008, using the following process:
  - a. The county clerk and recorder shall tally the results of the provisional ballots cast by voters on the list provided by the Secretary of State.
  - b. The county clerk and recorder shall submit the amended results, to include precinct totals, by email or fax and by certified mail to the Secretary of State.
  - c. The county clerk and recorder shall take such other steps as may be necessary to carry out this order, except that reconvening the canvass board shall not be required.
5. The Secretary of State may order additional ballots to be counted if the Secretary of State or the Court determines that certain voters' ineligibility has not been established by clear and convincing evidence. In the event of such a determination, the Secretary will issue a further Order with directions to the affected counties.

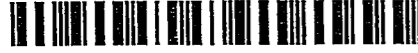
