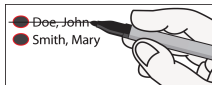

If you make an error on your selection, make a strikethrough across the oval and name or answer indicating your intent NOT to vote for that selection.

**WARNING:** Any person who, by use of force or other means, unduly influences an eligible elector to vote in any particular manner or to refrain from voting, or who falsely makes, alters, forges, or counterfeits any mail ballot before or after it has been cast, or who destroys, defaces, mutilates, or tampers with a ballot is subject, upon conviction, to imprisonment, or to a fine, or both. <p>Ballot questions referred by the general assembly or any political subdivision are listed by letter, and ballot questions initiated by the people are listed numerically. A ballot question listed as an "amendment" proposes a change to the Colorado constitution, and a ballot question listed as a "proposition" proposes a change to the Colorado Revised Statutes. A "yes/for" vote on any ballot question is a vote in favor of changing current law or existing circumstances, and a "no/against" vote on any ballot question is a vote against changing current law or existing circumstances.</p>	<p><b>Grand County Ballot Issue 1A</b> (Vote YES or NO)</p> <p>SHALL GRAND COUNTY TAXES BE INCREASED \$1,200,000.00 (ESTIMATED FIRST FULL FISCAL YEAR DOLLAR INCREASE) AND BY WHATEVER AMOUNTS ARE RAISED ANNUALLY, SOLELY FOR THE LIMITED PURPOSE OF DIRECTLY FUNDING URGENT PUBLIC SAFETY NEEDS REGARDING LAW ENFORCEMENT FACILITIES AND MEETING STATUTORY OBLIGATIONS OF GRAND COUNTY TO PROVIDE ADEQUATE DETENTION FACILITIES; SUCH TAX TO CONSIST OF A RATE INCREASE IN THE COUNTYWIDE SALES TAX OF 0.2% (WHICH REPRESENTS TWO-TENTHS OF ONE CENT ON EACH DOLLAR) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2020, AND EXPIRING ON DECEMBER 31, 2039, OR UPON FULL PAYMENT OF THE COSTS INCURRED TO ACCOMPLISH THE PURPOSES OF THE TAX, WHICHEVER IS EARLIER, AND WHICH TAX WILL NOT BE COLLECTED ON SALES OF PRESCRIPTION DRUGS, TO BE USED SOLELY FOR:</p> <p>CONSTRUCTION AND EQUIPPING OF PUBLIC SAFETY, 911 COMMUNICATIONS, AND DETENTION FACILITIES TO ADDRESS EXISTING SECURITY AND SAFETY CONCERNS OF THE RESIDENTS OF GRAND COUNTY, AS MORE FULLY DETAILED IN RESOLUTION 2019-9-1 OF THE GRAND COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.</p> <p>AND SHALL GRAND COUNTY BE AUTHORIZED TO COLLECT, RETAIN, AND SPEND THE PROCEEDS OF THE REVENUE FROM SUCH TAX AND ANY EARNINGS THEREON AS A VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE, AND AN EXCEPTION TO THE REVENUE AND SPENDING LIMITS OF ARTICLE 10, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION, OR ANY OTHER LAW?</p>

### Sunset Ridge, Grand County, Colorado, Public Improvement District Ballot Issue 1B

(Vote YES or NO)

SHALL SUNSET RIDGE, GRAND COUNTY, COLORADO, PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT, DEBT BE INCREASED UP TO \$1,800,000 WITH A MAXIMUM REPAYMENT COST OF UP TO \$2,498,000, AND SHALL DISTRICT TAXES BE INCREASED UP TO \$180,000 ANNUALLY OR SUCH LESSER AMOUNT AS MAY BE NECESSARY FOR THE PAYMENT OF SUCH DEBT AND ANY REFUNDINGS THEREOF FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING, LEASING, FINANCING OR REIMBURSING ALL OR ANY PART OF THE COSTS OF DESIGNING, CONSTRUCTING, INSTALLING, COMPLETING, PAVING, AND OTHERWISE PROVIDING STREETS, ROADS, AND ADJACENT IMPROVEMENTS, TOGETHER WITH INCIDENTAL COSTS RELATING TO SUCH PURPOSE, BY THE ISSUANCE AND PAYMENT OF BONDS, WHICH BONDS SHALL BEAR INTEREST AT A MAXIMUM NET EFFECTIVE INTEREST RATE NOT TO EXCEED 4.7% AND MATURE, BE SUBJECT TO REDEMPTION, WITH OR WITHOUT PREMIUM, AND BE ISSUED, DATED AND SOLD AT SUCH TIME OR TIMES, AT SUCH PRICES (AT, ABOVE OR BELOW PAR) AND IN SUCH MANNER AND CONTAINING SUCH TERMS, NOT INCONSISTENT HEREWITH, AS THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE DISTRICT MAY DETERMINE; SHALL AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAXES BE LEVIED IN ANY YEAR, WITHOUT LIMITATION AS TO RATE OR AMOUNT OR ANY OTHER CONDITION, TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF, PREMIUM, IF ANY, AND INTEREST ON SUCH BONDS AND TO FUND ANY RESERVES FOR THE PAYMENT THEREOF; AND SHALL THE PROCEEDS OF ANY SUCH BONDS AND THE REVENUE FROM SUCH TAXES, ANY OTHER REVENUE USED TO PAY SUCH BONDS, AND INVESTMENT EARNINGS THEREON (REGARDLESS OF AMOUNT) BE COLLECTED, RETAINED AND SPENT BY THE DISTRICT AS A VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE, WITHOUT REGARD TO ANY SPENDING, REVENUE-RAISING, OR OTHER LIMITATION CONTAINED WITHIN ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION, OR ANY OTHER LAW WHICH PURPORTS TO LIMIT THE DISTRICT'S REVENUES OR EXPENDITURES AS IT CURRENTLY EXISTS OR AS IT MAY BE AMENDED IN THE FUTURE, AND WITHOUT LIMITING IN ANY YEAR THE AMOUNT OF OTHER REVENUES THAT MAY BE COLLECTED, RETAINED AND SPENT BY THE DISTRICT?

### East Grand County Fire Protection District No. 4 Ballot Issue 6B

(Vote YES or NO)

WITHOUT RAISING THE MILL LEVY RATE FOR TAXES COLLECTED IN 2020, SHALL EAST GRAND COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 4 BE AUTHORIZED BEGINNING IN 2020 TO SET THE MILL LEVY AT A RATE SUFFICIENT TO GENERATE THE TAX REVENUES LEVIED FOR COLLECTION IN 2021, AS SUCH AMOUNT IS ADJUSTED ANNUALLY THEREAFTER FOR INFLATION AND LOCAL GROWTH, TO BE USED FOR OPERATING AND OTHER EXPENSES, INCLUDING:

1. MAINTAINING THE CURRENT LEVEL AND QUALITY OF RESPONSE,

3. MAINTAINING THE VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER BASE WITH CONTINUAL TRAINING,
4. EXPANDING SERVICES NECESSARY TO KEEP UP WITH POPULATION GROWTH, AND
5. MAINTAINING REVENUES WHICH WOULD OTHERWISE BE LOST DUE TO THE GALLAGHER AMENDMENT TO THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION;
