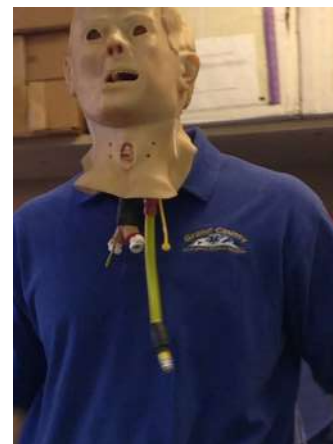

Hero- My dad Paul Sprague because of his work ethic.

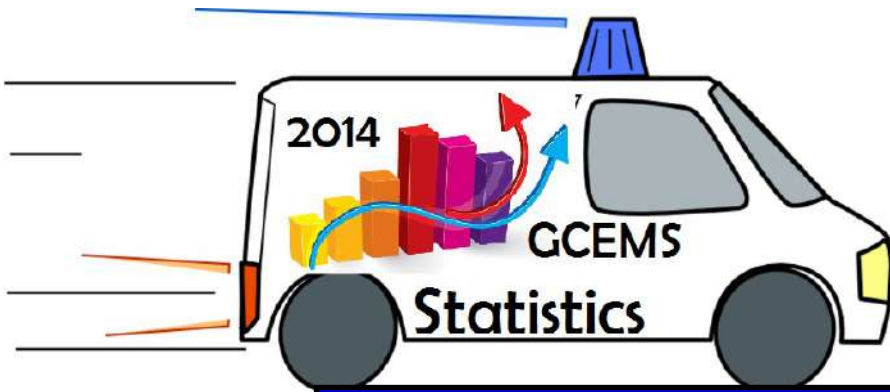
If you could choose one superhero power, what would it be?

Teleportation because you could ski BC, sunbath in Ibiza, and gamble in Vegas all in the same day.

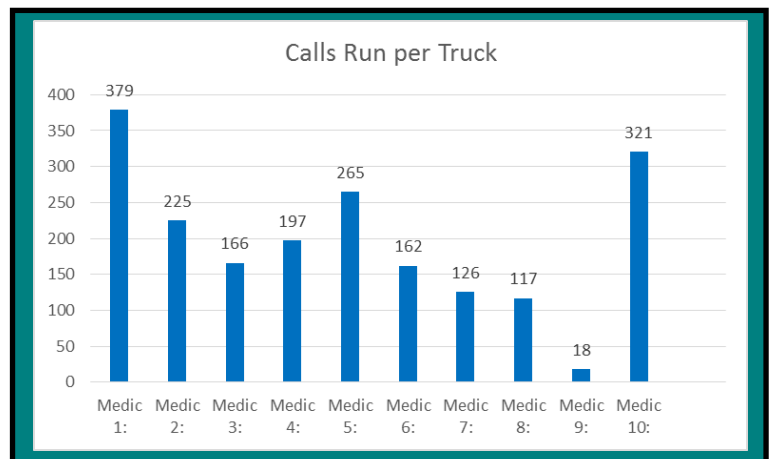
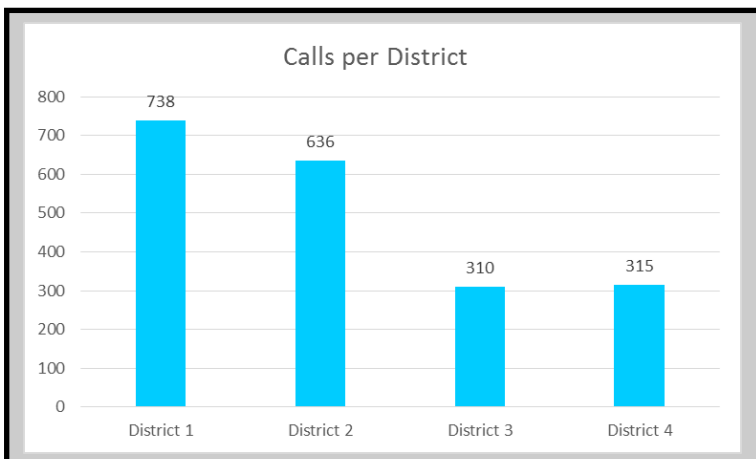
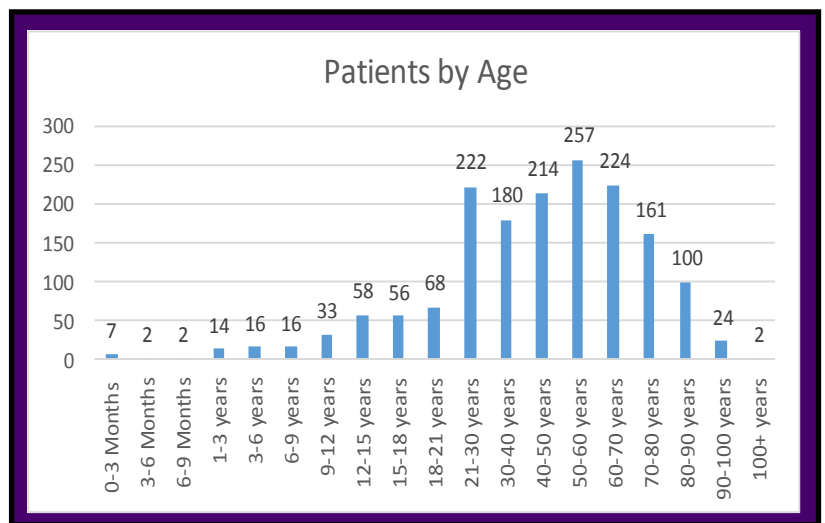
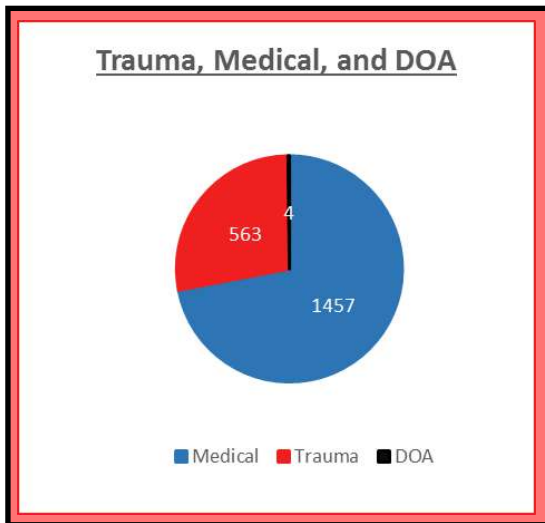
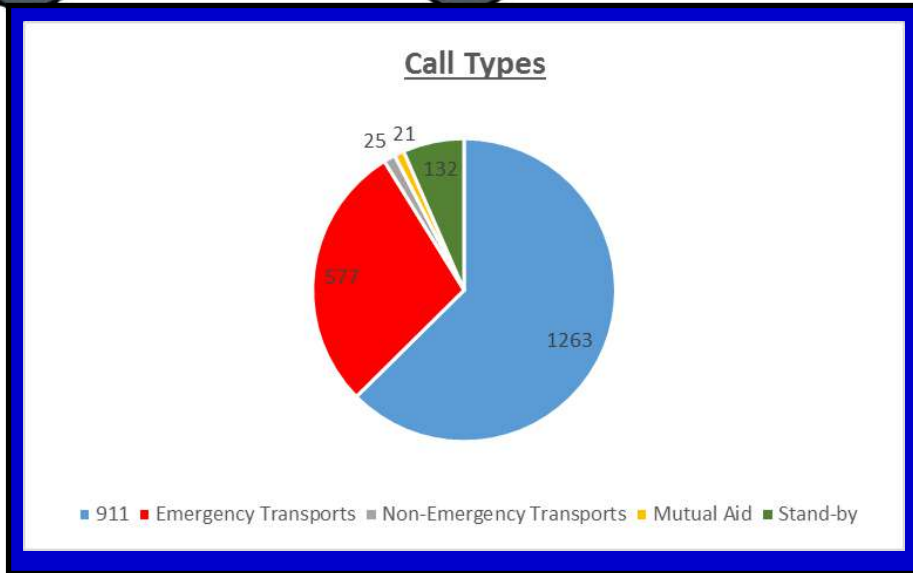
If you could have lunch with anyone, living or dead, who would it be? If I could have lunch with anyone it would be Michael Jordan because he is one of the greatest athletes of all time.
