My name is John Kane. I live at 1129 mountain avenue in Grand Lake. I cannot vote in Grand Lake because I must keep my Denver residency as my voting residence because of medical reasons. But I have been paying taxes in Grand county 44 years. I am writing simply to request that the commission approve the Igadl pot shop just outside of Granby. My reason is quite simple. Right now I have to drive all the way from Grand Lake to tabernash to obtain my recreational marijuana. I'm 78 years old and find that the marijuana use is very helpful for my relaxation and sleeping. It seems to me that it is ecologically unfriendly not to approve the shop outside of Granby. We are all concerned about gas emissions and I suspect I'm far from the only consumer of marijuana that wastes a lot of gas and produces a lot of pollution by having to travel to tabernash rather than to a much closer shop near Granby. So I hope that you will approve the pot shop outside of Granby despite granby's 10 year old vote to not allow that shop or any pot shop in or near Granby.
