## Overview, Target Audience and Learner Outcome

This conference is for interdisciplinary healthcare team members caring for pediatric patients in a variety of settings. As a result of this session, learners will be able to apply new knowledge related to pediatric specialty practice in order to provide current, evidence-based practice care to pediatric populations.

- Describe de-escalation techniques that can be used with an acutely agitated patient
- Identify sepsis and approach initial resuscitation including hemodynamic assessment, IV fluids and vasoactive agents based on the 2020 Pediatric Surviving Sepsis Guidelines
- Define febrile neutropenia, identify patient populations at risk and describe the basic management principles
- Discuss clinical updates on assessment, diagnosis and treatment for type 1 diabetes and diabetic ketoacidosis
- Discuss the latest information of the epidemiology, transmission, clinical presentation and treatment of SARS-CoV-2 infections in children including the Multisystem Inflammatory Syndrome in Children (MIS-C)
