## Congratulations to Grand County Residents!

As of April 29, 2021, Grand County is officially enrolled into the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP).

The sale of flood insurance through the NFIP is now available to all residents, renters, and business owners in unincorporated Grand County, Colorado. Additionally, coverage through the NFIP is available in the Towns of Fraser, Granby, Grand Lake, and Winter Park. Typically, there is a 30-day waiting period from the date of purchase until a flood insurance policy goes into effect. Contact your insurance agent to get a flood insurance policy today.

- Did you know that flood risk downslope and downstream of a burn scar is significantly higher for several years following a wildfire?
- Did you know that most homeowners, renters, and business insurance policies do not cover flood damage?
