Three wildfires have started in the last three days on the Front Range. With lingering memories of our own, and caring thoughts about what our eastern neighbors are going through, we thought it was a good time to share some **Be Wildfire Ready** reminders:

Sign up for emergency alerts.

Grand County uses the CodeRED system for emergency messages. Make sure you, your loved ones and neighbors are signed up. [Learn more and sign up.](#)

We also have a [Specific Needs Registry](#) for our community members who may need assistance in the event of an emergency. [Complete this form](#) for the people in your life not living in a residential facility who may need extra help during an emergency.

Know Your Zone.

Grand County's [interactive evacuation map](#) has areas labeled alpha-numerically. For example, the Town of Hot Sulphur Springs and the Administration Building are located in "HSS24." These labels are what will be used if an evacuation is ordered. **Please take a moment to identify which zone you and your loved ones live and work in.**

Be ready.

As many of our friends and neighbors learned in 2020, you may not have much time when you're told to evacuate. [Have a Go Bag](#) packed and ready for your family (including your furry members), and a plan. If you have livestock, make a plan **now** for moving them to safety.
