As required in the Permit Issued to Conduct a Designated Activity of State Interest or to Engage in Development in a Designated Area of State Interest in the County of Grand, Colorado for the 2012 Windy Gap Firming Project (2012 WGFP), dated December 4, 2012, the following is submitted in accordance with Condition 8, specifically the last item on the list of Related Documents:

Northern Water has agreed to make release of the 5,412.5 acre feet of water permanent as described in Paragraph 1.g. of the Intergovernmental Agreement between the Northern Colorado Water Conservancy District, Grand County, Middle Park Water Conservancy District, and Colorado River Water Conservation District, which was executed by Grand County on January 2, 2013 and Northern Water on January 11, 2013, which is attached to this letter.
